- Surname
- First name
- Organisation name
- e-mail address
- Language / Sound
- Picture
- Chat content

We use this data to

- Make the recording available to the participants if necessary
- Allow participants to access it later
- Create informal notes about discussions in the recorded meeting
- Create formal records of discussions, actions, agreements or decisions in the recorded meeting

We do not use this data for profiling or advertising.

Data recipients

We do not share your data outside of our own organisation and the invited meeting participants.

Scope of application

Duration of data retention

Recorded meetings are automatically deleted after 90 days unless they are saved by one of the participants to a location other than the original storage location.

Consent to data processing

You will be informed about the recording technically or organisationally at the start of the meeting. If you continue to participate in the online meeting after this notification, you declare your consent to the processing.

Rights of access, rectification and erasure

In the online meeting, you have the right to obtain information from us at any time about the data collected and to have incorrectly recorded data corrected.

Right of objection
